



KronoVox: The dark side of Synth Rock!

KronoVox is an electronic rock band blending synth-wave, electro-pop, and dark wave, with over a decade of trajectory since its formation in 2012. The band is composed of Leo Scherzo (vocals and guitar), Lourdes Aguirre “Duka” (keyboards and synthesizers), and Eduardo Aguirre “Neo” (drums). Together, they have crafted a distinctive sound that merges the raw energy of rock with immersive electronic textures, supported by a high-impact audiovisual identity.

Before forming KronoVox, its members were actively involved in Chicago’s indie alternative scene, participating in projects such as Crather, Subatómico, CF3, Nuvia, Tinta Plasma, and Mikltan. From the beginning, KronoVox has positioned itself as an innovative force within the emerging music circuit, recognized for both its sonic identity and visual approach.

With support from media outlets in the United States and internationally, KronoVox has built a loyal fanbase across countries including Mexico, Colombia, Germany, Spain, and the United Kingdom, earning consistent airplay and coverage on specialized platforms.

Throughout their career, they have performed at major festivals such as Ruido Fest, Hispano Fest, Fiesta del Sol, and Escándalo Fest, sharing the stage with acts like Moenia, Enjambre, Little Jesus, Enanitos Verdes, and Elefante. They have also collaborated with artists such as Alfonso Pichardo, lead vocalist of Moenia, on tracks like “Corazón Digital” and “A Dónde,” as well as with The CF3 and Di Wav. Part of their catalog has been co-produced by Reuven Amiel, a Latin Grammy-winning producer.

In 2023, KronoVox joined Moenia on the “Pixel Tour” in Chicago, performing their collaboration “Corazón Digital” live alongside Alfonso Pichardo. In 2024, they released the single “Lluvia,” accompanied by a music video filmed at CineSpace Chicago. In 2026, the band was invited as a special guest on the “La Culpa es de los 80s VIP” tour in Mexico City, where they shared the stage with iconic Spanish-language rock and pop acts such as Kenny y los Eléctricos, Fandango, Micro Chips, and Ritmo Peligroso. Their performances were met with a strong audience response and positive media reception, further solidifying their presence in the Mexican market.

KronoVox is currently promoting their latest single, “Ser Intensa,” a track that blends lush synthesizers with emotionally charged electric guitars, reinforcing their sonic identity and evolution within contemporary electro rock. With a sound that bridges electronic atmospheres and rock intensity, KronoVox continues to expand its reach through new releases and live performances, positioning itself as one of the most compelling electro rock acts in the Spanish-speaking scene.
